REACH OUT CAN HELP YOU!

WHEN IS IT?

You can tell us what days and times you most need the support. We will then offer you help at an agreed time, weekly, for an agreed time limited period of up to six months.

WHERE IS IT?

In your own home.

WHAT HAPPENS THERE?

A trained Volunteer helps with issues you identify as priorities. For example they might:

- ❖ Provide an extra pair of hands on practical issues
- ❖ Enable you to spend time with siblings
- ❖ Give information about local sources of support and advice
- ❖ Work alongside you to develop your child's communication and interaction.

TELL ME MORE...

Resources for Autism's Reach Out service offers home-based support **FREE**, to families affected by autism spectrum conditions. We provide a trained Volunteer to visit your family weekly.

Volunteers liaise with professionals working with your family and aim to support the work that they are doing.

All Volunteers attend a training programme before they start, have a Criminal Records Bureau check and provide references.
