#### What are Short Breaks?

Short Breaks give children and young people with disabilities the opportunity to enjoy positive activities, while giving their parents or carers a break from caring responsibilities.

## They come in three levels:

- Universal available to all families
- Targeted for those needing extra support to access services
- Specialist for those with high levels of care needs, requiring social care support

#### **Universal Short Breaks**

These are mainstream activities available to all children, with or without disabilities.

# Examples:

- Youth clubs
- Adventure playgrounds
- Holiday schemes

#### Cost:

- Usually paid for by parents/carers
- Some services may offer discounts or concessions for children with disabilities: ask the provider directly

Parents are responsible for choosing and assessing the safety/quality of the activity. Providers must make reasonable adjustments under the Equality Act 2010.



## **Targeted Short Breaks**

These are for children who cannot access universal services without extra support due to their disability.

Eligibility:

- Under 18
- Live in Lewisham
- Diagnosed disability
- In receipt of the Higher Rate Care Component of DLA
- Not already receiving Specialist Short Breaks

If your child does not receive the higher rate DLA, you can still apply and be assessed by the Care Package Panel.

# What you may get:

- 100 hours of short breaks annually through:
  - o Direct Payments to arrange your own support
  - Support at home
- Referrals to:
  - Rockbourne Holiday Club
  - Rockbourne Saturday Club
  - Rockbourne SEN Evening Club

## How to apply:

Apply online or via your professional (e.g. teacher or social worker). Applications are reviewed individually.



# **Specialist Short Breaks**

These are for children with complex needs that require substantial care and who have undergone a social care assessment.

# **Eligibility:**

- Under 18
- Live in Lewisham
- Have a diagnosed disability
- Substantial impact on daily life due to disability
- Must undergo a Social Care Assessment first

## Support is based on the outcome of this assessment

# Specialist services include:

- Peter Every House
- Young Person Relate (YPR)
- Drumbeat Holiday Services
- Lewisham Council Short Breaks
- Domiciliary care
- Direct Payments



#### **How to Access Short Break Services**

You can access short breaks by first having a Social Care Assessment. This assessment will help decide if your child is eligible for targeted or specialist short break services.

#### Who Can Make a Referral?

Referrals for a Social Care Assessment can be made by:

- Your child's school
- Another local council
- A health visitor or health professional
- You, the parent or carer

#### How to Make a Referral

# **Urgent Referrals**

If you are concerned about a child's safety:

- Call Family First Contact Point (FFCP) on 020 8314 9181 for urgent child protection matters
- If a child is in immediate danger, call 999
- For non-emergency police matters, call 101



# What Happens After You Make a Referral?

#### After a referral is made:

- We will check if your child meets the Children with Disabilities eligibility criteria
- If they do, a Social Work Manager will decide whether to allocate a Social Worker

#### **Assessment Timeframes**

- If allocated, the assessment must be completed within 45 days
- Usually, assessments are done within 35-45 days
- If there are safeguarding concerns, the assessment will happen within 10 days

# **What Happens After the Assessment?**

Your child's social worker will decide one of the following:

- Your child does not need a service
- Your child can be supported by universal services
- Your child needs additional support through a care plan

#### If a Care Plan is Needed

# If your child needs a care plan:

- The social worker will write a plan setting out the services your child will receive
- The plan is reviewed by a manager
- It is then presented to the Care Package Panel for final agreement
